The UoE Change Up Transdisciplinary HE Pedagogy Network was established in 2022 and aims to develop a connected UoE research community focused on transdisciplinary and creative HE research and pedagogy which can drive change. It is co-led by Associate Professor Kerry Chappell, Dr Caitlin Kight and Professor Nicky King. The network promotes and shares ideas about teaching that can facilitate students to respond to urgent 'wicked' problems, e.g., climate change, health crises, issues of social justice. We also aim to raise awareness of the importance of excellent transdisciplinary pedagogic research, and what it looks and feels like.
