Camborne 2025 - The 47th Intercollegiate Mining Games





Introduction

The Camborne School of Mines (CSM) International Mining Games Teams are pleased to present this business proposal offering an opportunity to sponsor and advertise your company at Camborne 2025 - The 47th Intercollegiate Mining Games.

The 2025 games will be held from the 19th - 22nd March 2025 at King Edward Mine Museum (KEMM) which was the home of Camborne School of Mines from 1897, and has played host to all generations of CSM students. The 47th edition of the games will be the third time the UK has hosted with CSM holding both the 2012 and 2018 games at KEMM, we look forward to making this edition the best one yet!

After an outstanding performance by both CSM teams in the 2024 games, with our women's team finishing 2nd overall and our Men's placing 8th overall, we wish to use the home advantage to better that this year. We will strive to enter five CSM teams in this year's competition which would see up to thirty individuals carrying sponsor's logos, displaying them to mining and geology students and alumni from across the globe.

There are a variety of ways that companies or individuals can support the Camborne 2025 event. Sponsorship can be by financial means, equipment purchases, or expertise donation and all help is greatly appreciated to allow us to continue taking part and organising this unique event. All support will be put towards the cost of hosting the competition events, ground preparation and training.

History of the Games

On the 2nd of May 1972, a fire broke out in the Sunshine Mine, near Kellogg, Idaho, USA. At the time, 178 miners were working underground. Carbon Monoxide, heat and smoke spread quickly through the tunnels, immediately killing many and hampering the efforts of rescue workers. Initially, 85 miners escaped safely, and two more were rescued seven days later. However, it took until the 13th of May before the last victims were brought out of the mine. The tragedy was America's worst mining disaster since 1917.

The competition was started in 1978 in honour of the 91 miners that died in the Sunshine Mine disaster and to remember miners that have since perished in the line of duty. The primary aim of the competition is to keep the traditional mining techniques alive, many of which were developed in Cornwall. The competition has now evolved and provides a talent scouting opportunity for mining companies and companies in related sectors. They enhance the camaraderie of the mining students over international borders.

The 2024 teams were fortunate enough to visit the site of the Sunshine Mine memorial during the 46th Intercollegiate Mining Games in Butte, Montana.



The Events

The competition consists of seven events: Jackleg Drilling, Hand Steeling, Swede Saw, Hand Mucking, Surveying, Track stand and Gold Panning. The games are highly competitive, with teams entering from mining schools in Australia, America, Canada and mainland Europe. There are separate men's, women's and co-ed competitions. An alumni competition also runs alongside the event. Each team consists of 6 members, with five persons competing in most events with surveying and jackleg requiring only two.



Event: Swede Saw

Description: Saw through a 6" x 6" piece of timber with a 36" bow saw.

Main equipment: Bow saws, saw teeth, timber.



Event: Gold Pan

Description: Find five flattened lead or copper ball bearings in a pan full of dirt and rock.

Main equipment: Trough, gold pans, muck.



Event: Hand Steel

Description: Drill into a concrete block using a 4lb hammer and a 7/8" chisel. **Main equipment:** Hammers, steels, concrete blocks, water containers.



Event: Trackstand

Description: Set up and tear down a section of track, including sleepers, rail,

connecting plates and bolts.

Main equipment: Sleepers, rail, spikes, picks, lump hammers, spike removers, fish plates,

concrete blocks.



Event: Jackleg Drilling

Description: Drill into a vertical rock or concrete face using a pneumatic airleg drill.

Main equipment: Drill steels, concrete blocks, compressor, air tank, hex drill bits, drills

and airlegs.



Event: Hand Mucking

Description: Run an ore cart down a 75' section of track and fill it with muck using shovels.

Main equipment: Ore carts, shovels, rail, sleepers, concrete blocks, muck.



Event: Surveying

Description: Teams are given a starting point and expected to report the coordinates of a

finishing point using an old-fashioned Vernier transit.

Main Equipment: Theodolite, Tripod, Calculator
